WHAT IF I WANTED TO COOPERATE BUT I MISSED A MEETING WITH CHILD SUPPORT?

If you miss a meeting or hearing, but have an adequate reason, you should not be found in non-cooperation.

Adequate reasons include:

Mail from Child Support going to the wrong address;

Natural disaster;

A critical illness of you or a family member that you had to care for; or

A family crisis requiring your full attention.
